Big Picture Realities of EB-5

- Most investors come from China and too few visas are available for Chinese investors.
 - Lots of visas still left for the rest of the world, though....
- Changes everywhere:
 - New legislation likely—eventually
 - Recently proposed regulatory changes—major \$\$\$ increase
 - New U.S. President—difficult to determine ultimate impact on EB-5 statutes, regulations, and policies

Potential legislative changes:

- Investment amount might increase to \$800,000 (TEA) and \$1.2 million (non-TEA)
- Investor might need to be at least 18 years old
- Integrity measures may require disclosure of fees that agents earn
- TEAs (urban vs. rural; set asides, etc.); industry preferences for manufacturing and infrastructure

Potential regulatory changes:

- Increase in minimum investment amount to \$1.35 million (TEA) or \$1.8 million (everywhere else)
- Priority date retention (allows investor of approved I-526 petition to retain their priority date if he or she needs to file another petition for some reason)

Trump as new President:
